Town of Keenesburg, CO Announces Actions in Response to Coronavirus

The goal of the Town of Keenesburg is to assure the safety and health of our employees as well as the general public while continuing to deliver municipal services to the community. In response to guidance from the CDC, Weld County and the Governor's Office, the Town of Keenesburg is taking the following steps to mitigate the spread of the coronavirus:

- A declaration of emergency has been declared for the Town of Keenesburg
- Town Hall Closed
- On call staff for public works
- Administration working from home when applicable
- All public gatherings are canceled to include:
 - April 11 Easter Egg Hunt
 - April 18 Arbor Day
 - April 25 Rabies Clinic
- All public meetings will be held via electronic means and will be posted as such to allow the public to attend via conference call and or video conference.
