

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-03

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE TOWN OF KEENESBURG'S GRANT APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (HSIP) FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) has announced that it is soliciting applications for federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds; and

WHEREAS, HSIP provides funds for projects that improve highway safety at locations where there is the highest potential for crash reduction; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is of the opinion that installing traffic signals at the intersection of State Highway 52 and County Road 59 would improve highway safety and reduce the possibility of traffic accidents, including those that involve fatalities and serious injuries; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes the Town should apply to CDOT for HSIP funding for the traffic signal project and by this resolution desires to express its support for such grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF KEENESBURG, COLORADO:

Section 1. The Board of Trustees strongly supports the application to the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) for federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds, which such funds will be used for the installation of traffic signals at the intersection of State Highway 52 and County Road 59.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees acknowledges that the grant application includes matching funds which the Town is solely responsible to provide if a grant is awarded.
