The Town of Keenesburg welcomes our new residents, please do not hesitate to contact Town Hall with any questions or concerns: 303-732-4281. Also, please be aware of the following:

- Water/sewer bills are processed on the 1st of each month and are due on the 20th.
- Dogs within town limits must be licensed. Please provide proof of vaccinations of Rabies, Distemper & Parvo by a licensed veterinarian. Licenses are \$5 per dog. Maximum of three (3) Dogs are allowed. (Keenesburg Municipal Code Chapter 7, Title 6)
- No dumpsters or dumpster type waste containers having a capacity of more than ninety-six (96) gallons shall be allowed in an R-1 zone district or on a property within any zone district upon which a single-family dwelling is located. (Keenesburg Municipal Code 7-1-40)
- Please contact Town Hall if you are planning a remodel or adding a structure to your property as building permits are required. (KMC Chapters 16 and 18)

AC Pipe Replacement & Market Storm Drainage Project

Please be cautious around the construction crew and slow down as the Speed Limit has changed. Although this is a lengthy and difficult project, we are doing our best to ensure the areas remain safe for the crew and town residents. The project will continue through October and scheduled to be completed in three phases: Phase I: Gandy, from Main Street to alley east of Main Street; Miller Street, from Kipp Avenue to one-half block north; Stewart Street, from Woodward Avenue to Kipp Avenue; Woodward Avenue, from Elm Street to Miller Street; Market Street, CR 398 to N 1st Street; N 1st Street, from Market Street to Cedar. Phase II: Woodard Avenue, from Miller Street to CR 59. Phase III: Market Street, from Broadway Avenue to CR 398. We understand the inconvenience of the partial road closures, we appreciate your patience during these much-needed repairs.
